Suggested items:

The following are items that may be brought to school, should you wish, but there is no compulsion to do so

- Personal effects, such as family photos
- Posters
- Personal mp3 players/iPods

Please note

1. Students are encouraged to have mobile phones for contact with parents. There will be clear rules about the use of mobile phones during the School day, the evenings and at weekends.
2. Please do not bring large electrical items such as toasters, fridges, kettles, games consoles e.g. Xbox etc. Other than a mobile phone and the student's laptop, students should not need any other electrical communication devices (eg ipad etc).
3. All medicines must be handed to the House Master or House Mistress on arrival. The Health Care Centre will administer all prescribed medicines to students. No student should keep un-prescribed medicines such as Paracetamol.
4. There should be no need for cash on the School campus. However, if it is specifically requested for a certain event, all pupils below the Sixth Form must hand it to their House Master or House Mistress and can withdraw it when required.
5. Given the School uniform and sports kit requirements, storage space for casual clothing will be limited. Students should avoid bringing more than the recommended amount of casual clothing.
