

BOARDING KIT LIST

In addition to normal School uniform, PE/sports kit and equipment and musical instruments, boarders should bring the items below to their Houses at the start of term.

Please ensure everything (including clothes, footwear, linen, personal items, sports and musical equipment) **is clearly and securely named.**

- A single lightweight duvet
- 2 duvet covers
- 2 bedsheets
- 1 pillow
- 2 pillowcases
- 1 towel for swimming
- 2 medium-sized towels
- Alarm clock
- Casual clothing for a minimum of two evenings
- Clothes hangers
- Octopus card
- Padlock (for locker)
- Personal wash kit / toiletries / insect repellent / sun cream
- Pyjamas
- Slippers / flip flops
- Water bottle

These are the recommended amounts of uniform items for boarders to bring in each week:

- 5 school shirts
- 2 pairs trousers / skirts
- 3-4 sets of PE kit
- 5 pairs navy / black socks
- 2 School laundry bags (ordered through the school uniform shop)

In addition, the following are suggested items for boarders to bring in:

- Personal effects, such as family photos
- Posters / Photos for pin boards (no BluTack may be used on school walls)
- E-readers

Please note:

1. A twice-weekly laundry service is available for boarders' use.
2. Pupils are encouraged to have mobile phones for contact with parents. There are clear rules about the use of mobile phones during the School day and the evenings.
3. Please do not bring in large electrical items such as toasters, fridges, kettles, games consoles etc. Other than a mobile phone and the pupil's laptop, pupils do not need any other electrical communication devices (e.g. iPads)
4. All medicines must be handed to the Health Care Centre on arrival. The Health Care Centre will administer all prescribed medicines to pupils. No pupil may keep unprescribed medicines such as Paracetamol.
5. Cash and valuables should be kept to an absolute minimum in School (there is no need for cash on the School campus). On occasion, cash may be required for a certain event, but it must still be kept to a minimum.
6. Given the School uniform and sports kit requirements, storage space for casual clothing and shoes is limited, so pupils should avoid bringing more than the recommended amount (above).
